EX-GRATIA GRANT FROM CANTEEN TRADE SURPLUS (CTS)

1. Refer to Para 4(b)(vi) CGHQ policy letter AD/0316/CTS dated 02 Jun 14.
2. The Competent Authority has approved grant of ex-gratia under serial 'Demise Grant' from Canteen Trade Surplus (CTS), in addition to the benefit provided by CGBA as follows:-

3. It is clarified that the grant, being a benevolent measure and directly linked to disbursement of CTS to ICG from DDG Canteen Services, cannot be claimed as a matter of right / compulsion by the family members of deceased and will be subject to the timely distribution of CTS fund to ICG.
4. The Demise Grant corpus will be centrally controlled from CGHQ through Directorate of Administration. The requirements of ex-gratia to above mentioned categories, if any, may be forwarded to CGHQ as and when situation arises for early disbursement of funds.
